MINUTES OF THE CHURCH BUSINESS MEETING

March 17, 2013

The meeting was called to order by Mike York, Moderator, at 12:42 p.m. Attendance was 35.

The agenda was approved as presented.

The minutes of the January 20, 2013, business meeting were accepted as presented. It was pointed out that two of the percentage figures for votes in the Minutes of the Church Special-Called Business Meeting were incorrect and should read as follows:

ORGANIZATIONAL REPORTS

Finance Committee by John Roden, Chairman

John presented the year-end Cash Flow Statement, noting that the \$14,872.13 cash flow YTD shows we were able to meet our budget without the special large gift received last year. We also paid down over \$600,000 of the debt on our building. The cash flow statement for January 31, 2013, shows a negative cash flow YTD of \$29,475.53, but the occurrence of three payroll dates in January is the reason for that. The Building to Glorify Reserve and Property Reserve were moved into interest-bearing accounts.

Mike thanked the Finance Committee for their hard work in overseeing the Church's monetary issues.
